



Prevent Protocol

Due to the present situation in the Middle –East, British citizens being recruited to go to Syria and the ‘Trojan Horse’ issue in Birmingham we are now working with the Prevent programme in an effort to help and support any of our students who may be vulnerable/open to influence from certain extremist factions

1. Staff please be aware and take note of any student(s) who express views that could be interpreted as pro–extremist (professional judgement will be needed as to whether the statements/views are bravado/showing off or more serious)
2. If there is a serious suspicion then please report this to Farhan Adam (Principal) immediately
3. The Principal will interview the student in question and inform Kate Bishop (Welfare) of the interview
If there is a positive response from the student this will mean no further action is required, other than the interview being recorded
4. A negative response will mean that the Principal contacts Parent/Guardian and arranges an interview with them and the student
Positive response will mean no further action required, other than recording
5. A negative response will mean contacting the Prevent Team
6. Prevent team work with the student and the family
